an assault pistol, as defined in § 4–301 of this article;

- 4 (3) A PERSON MAY NOT COMMIT AN ASSAULT BY INTENTIONALLY 5 SUFFOCATING OR STRANGLING ANOTHER.
- 6 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of the felony of assault in the first degree and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 25 years.
