- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 A person who attempts to commit murder in the second degree is guilty of a felony 16 and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding [30] **40** years.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 October 1, 2020.
