

- 1 (3) one shall be an individual who is a parent or guardian of a youth who 2 has been under the jurisdiction of the Department; [and]
- 3 (4) one shall be a victim advocate; AND
- 4 (5) TWO SHALL BE EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT WITH 5 DIFFERENT JOB TITLES, RECOMMENDED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE AMERICAN 6 FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY, AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES, COUNCIL 3.
- 7 (c) (1) The term of a member is 3 years.
- 8 (2) The terms of the members are staggered as required by the terms 9 provided for members of the State Advisory Board on October 1, 2007.
- 10 (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is 11 appointed and qualifies.
- 12 (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the 13 rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- 14 (5) A member who serves two consecutive full 3-year terms may not be reappointed for 3 years after completion of those terms.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2020.
